Whit Firor Music Scholarship

The Whit Firor Music Scholarship was endowed by the late Whit Firor in 1995.

Whit Firor was a cardiologist and teacher with the Royal University Hospitals in

Saskatoon. In addition to his medical career, Whit was a pilot, a passionate music lover,

and an accomplished Jazz pianist. Through his own musical pursuits, he realized that

music transcends regional and national borders. With that in mind, he initiated this

scholarship to create opportunity for Saskatchewan musicians, composers, and arrangers

to study abroad.

The scholarship, in the amount of \$1000 - \$5000, is for instrumentalists, composers, and arrangers from Saskatchewan who will be pursuing their musical education abroad. At present, only those candidates attending institutions qualified as "Donee" institutions by the Canadian Income Tax Act are eligible. This list is very comprehensive and includes many institutions in North America and Europe.

Typically, applicants will have demonstrated a degree of accomplishment and recognition and will have attained a point where further studies require them to travel outside the province. This scholarship intends to support the music community in Saskatchewan and therefore, community involvement on the applicant's behalf will be considered by the scholarship committee. It is the goal of both the scholarship's benefactor and the scholarship committee that we be as flexible as possible in our interpretation of what defines a music education and in what criteria is used in determining the successful applicant(s).
