Description: Beginning in the late 1990s, the Saskatoon Community Foundation (then known as the Saskatoon Foundation) partnered with the Muttart Foundation on its Youth Granting for Youth Program (YGY). In 2001 and 2002, the Saskatoon Community Foundation raised funds to create **the Batting 1000 Endowment for Children and Youth**. In 2004, the Saskatoon Community Foundation launched its own Youth Advisory Council (YAC). Beginning in 2013, at the request of the YAC, the **Batting 1000 Endowment for Children and Youth** was renamed **Youth Endowment Saskatoon**.

Focus Areas	All projects must benefit Children and Youth Annual focus areas set by Youth Advisory Council prior to launch
Funding Term	One-time grants, timeline per approved application
Intake Deadline	Applications: March 1 annually
Eligibility	Applicants: Qualified Donee: A qualified donee is an organization that can issue official donation receipts for gifts it receives from individuals and corporations. It can also receive gifts from registered charities. "Qualified donees" includes a number of types of organizations, but for typical granting purposes of the Foundation, refers to: registered charities, municipalities and municipal or public bodies performing a function of government in Canada. Focus Area: Children and Youth Geographical Area: Projects to benefit City of Saskatoon, except portion of McGillivray Fund, which can be granted throughout Saskatchewan
Not Eligible	If evaluation reports from previous years not submitted by deadline
