**Description:** Beginning in the late 1990s, the Saskatoon Community Foundation (then known as the Saskatoon Foundation) partnered with the Muttart Foundation on its Youth Granting for Youth Program (YGY). In 2001 and 2002, the Saskatoon Community Foundation raised funds to create **the Batting 1000 Endowment for Children and Youth**. In 2004, the Saskatoon Community Foundation launched its own Youth Advisory Council (YAC). Beginning in 2013, at the request of the YAC, the **Batting 1000 Endowment for Children and Youth** was renamed **Youth Endowment Saskatoon**.
