38 Years of Heart

The Foundation celebrated its 38th year on April 18th. About 300 people joined the celebration held at the Broadway Theatre. The party included a private screening of the little movie with a big heart-The Ultimate Gift-starring James Garner, Bills Cobbs, Drew Fuller, Abigail Breslin and Brian Dennehy.



The Foundation was the brainchild of seven of our city's well-known leaders: Fred MacDermid, attorney; Sid Buckwold, business owner and future Senator; Dr. Austin Forsyth, optometrist; Blair Nelson, broadcaster; Dr. Jack Leddy, surgeon; Albert Flavelle, automobile dealer and Allan Tubby, engineer. With the Winnipeg Foundation, established in 1921, as their model, they drafted the Saskatoon Foundation Act, proclaimed in the provincial legislature on April 18th, 1970.
